Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the presented design, to the submissions lodged in connection with the Fire Safety Certificate application and the appeal, and to the report and recommendation of the reporting Inspector, it is considered that it has been demonstrated by the appellant that the provision of a second (alternative) escape stair is not a requirement that is necessary to demonstrate compliance with

Technical Guidance Document B - Fire Safety (2006, reprinted 2022 and that is the relevant edition of the technical guidance in respect of the current appeal) or accordingly to demonstrate compliance with the requirements of Part B of the Second Schedule to the Building Regulations 1997, as amended. Therefore Condition 2 as originally attached by the Building Control Authority to the Fire Safety Certificate is not necessary.
