Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the presented design of the proposed development and the accompanying compliance report, to the submissions made in connection with the Disability Access Certificate application and the appeal, and to the report and recommendation of the reporting inspector, it is considered that it has been demonstrated by the appellant in the Disability Access Certificate application and appeal that the works to which the application and appeal relates would, if constructed in accordance with the plans, specifications and particulars submitted, and subject to compliance with the conditions attached, save condition 8 which shall be omitted and Conditions 2 and 3 which shall be amended, comply with the
