Reasons and Considerations

It is the policy of the planning authority as set out in the Limerick City and County Development Plan 2022-2028, including Objective CGR O1 and Policy CGR P3, to control urban sprawl and ribbon development. When taken in conjunction with existing development in the vicinity of the site, the proposed development would not be in accordance with this policy, as it would consolidate and contribute to the buildup of ribbon development and unsustainable urban sprawl in an open rural area. This would militate against the preservation of the rural environment and agricultural lands and would lead to demands for the provision of urban type services which would be uneconomic and inappropriate in such a rural setting. The proposed

development would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
