## DRAFT WORDING FOR ORDER

## **Reasons and Considerations**

Having regard to the Cork City Development Plan 2022-2028, in particular Section 11.192 (Casinos/Private Members' Clubs) and Section 11.193 (Shop Fronts, Advertising & Security Signs), the nature of the existing shopfront at the site and the shopfronts in the area, the design of the proposed alterations and upgrades to improve the appearance of the existing shopfront, and the location of the site within an Architectural Conservation Area, it is considered that that the proposal to retain the existing sliding doors would not be significantly detrimental to the architectural interest of the building or to the historic character of the area. It is also considered that details of a revised proposal for glazing and signage, by way of window display, is a matter to be agreed by the developer with the planning authority, prior to the commencement of development.
