## **Reasons and Considerations**

Having regard to the presented design of the proposed amendments to the Existing Public House and the accompanying compliance report, to the submissions made in connection with the Revised Disability Access Certificate application and the appeal, and to the report and recommendation of the reporting inspector, it is considered that

it has been demonstrated by the appellant in the Revised Disability Access
Certificate application and appeal that the requirements set out in the above
conditions are not required in order to meet the requirements of Part M of the
Second Schedule to the Building Regulations 1997, as amended. Therefore
conditions No.2, 3 and 4 as originally attached by the Building Control Authority to
the Revised Disability Access Certificate are not necessary to demonstrate
compliance with Part M of the Second Schedule to the Building Regulations 1997, as
amended. It is considered that the proposed works if constructed in accordance with
the design presented with the application and the appeal, would comply with the
requirements of Part M of the second schedule to the Building Regulations (as
amended).
