Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the presented design for the material alterations in connection with the Fire Safety Certificate application and the appeal, and to the report and recommendation of the reporting inspector, it is considered that Condition number 1 and Condition number 2 as originally attached by the Building Control Authority to the fire safety certificate are reasonably necessary to satisfy the requirements of Part B, specifically B1 (Means of escape in case of fire) and B5 (Access and facilities for

the fire service) of Technical Guidance Document Part B 2006. The Commission concluded with respect to these conditions that it has not been demonstrated by the appellant in the fire safety application and appeal documentation that the proposed compensatory measures are sufficient to deem the proposal to meet the requirements of the Building Regulations without the relevant conditions.
