Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the configuration of the subject site, the relationship between the subject dwelling and the adjoining properties and the need to protect the residential amenity of the neighbouring dwellings, it is considered that the requirements under

Condition 2 are reasonable and necessary to avoid excessive overlooking of the adjoining private open space of no. 9 Castlesize Court. Subject to compliance with the conditions attached to the permission, the proposed development, would not seriously injure the amenities of the area and would be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
