Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the existing building on site and the site's location in a mixed-use area characterised by the transition between Newbridge town centre to the west and lower order retail and commercial uses to the east, the surrounding pattern of development, and the nature, scale and intended use of the proposed development, it is considered that the imposition of condition number 2 is not warranted and that the proposed development would accord with the applicable land use zoning and would not seriously injure the amenities of the area.

The proposed development would, therefore, be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
