Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the residential land use zoning for the site, the pattern of development in the area, it is considered that, by reason of its limited scale, nature and design, and its location with respect to adjoining properties, the proposed dormer extension would not detract from the character of the dwelling or the visual amenities of the area and would not seriously injure the amenities of the area or of property in the vicinity by reason of overlooking or loss of privacy.
