Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the nature, scale and location of the proposed development in proximity to Portmarnock rail station and the pattern of development in the area, it is considered that the proposed change of use of public open space, the construction of gate and railings with all associated site works would enhance the permeability and accessibility of the area. The proposed development would not have a significant impact on the residential or visual amenities of the area, would comply with policy CMP14 and objective CMO19 of the Fingal County Development Plan 2023-2029, and would therefore, be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
