The submissions on file and the inspector's report were considered at a Meeting held on 24/04/2026.

Having regard to the anticipated energy output of the proposed thermal power station the Commission considered that the proposed development constitutes development that falls within the relevant definition of energy infrastructure in the Seventh Schedule of the Planning & Development Act, 2000 (as amended), thereby satisfying the requirements set out in section 37A(1) of the Act.

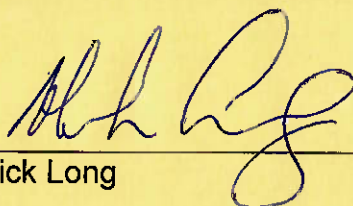
The proposed development is also considered to be of strategic importance by reference to the requirements of sections 37A(2)(a) and (b) of the Planning & Development Act, 2000 (as amended). The Commission is of the opinion that the proposed development constitutes a strategic infrastructure development within the meaning of section 37A of the Act and an application for permission for the proposed development must therefore be made directly to An Bord Pleanála under section 37E of the Planning & Development Act, 2000 (as amended).

The Commission determined that the prospective applicant should be notified that the consultation process is closed.
