DRAFT WORDING FOR ORDER

Reasons and Considerations

It is considered that it has been shown that -

- (i) the development, in respect of which a decision to grant permission has been made, will differ materially from the development as set out in the application for permission by reason of Condition number 9 imposed by the planning authority to which the grant is subject, and

- (ii) the imposition of Condition number 9 will materially affect the applicant's enjoyment of the land adjoining the land in respect of which it has been decided to grant permission or reduce the value of the land.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to Condition number 9, the Commission considers that the removal of construction access via Mount Green Road constitutes a material change to the development as set out in the application and further information submitted. While the condition itself did not stipulate an alternative construction access, the Commission considered that construction access via the alternative access referred to in the submissions on file, i.e., through Caisleán Nua, would materially affect the applicant's enjoyment of their land adjoining the land in respect of which it has been decided to grant permission.
