At a meeting held on October 26<sup>th</sup> 2017, the Board considered:

- (a) the objection made to the Compulsory Purchase Order,
- (b) the report of the Inspector who held the oral hearing and
- (c) the documents and submissions on file generally.

The Board decided to confirm the Order without modification for the following reasons and considerations.

### **Reasons and Considerations**

Having considered the objection made to the compulsory purchase order and not withdrawn, the report and recommendation of the person who conducted the oral hearing into the objection, the purpose for which the lands in question are to be acquired, and also having regard to the following:

- (a) the purposes of the compulsory purchase order for the provision of a burial ground,
- (b) the provisions of the Kerry County Development Plan 2015 – 2021,
- (c) the community need, public interest served and overall benefits to be achieved from the proposed development,

(d) the submissions and observations made at the oral hearing, and

(e) the report and recommendation of the Inspector,

it is considered that the acquisition of lands as set out in the order, schedules and on the deposit maps is necessary for the purposes stated in the order and that the objection cannot be sustained having regard to this necessity.
