The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at a Board meeting held on January 26th 2017.

The Board decided to refuse the licence, generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation, for the following reasons and considerations.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the location of the proposed tables and chairs at a point where there is a high pedestrian footfall in close proximity to a carpark, a pedestrian crossing, and the junction between Strand Road and Putland Road, it is considered that the placing of tables, chairs, and associated screens and planters, at this location would significantly impede pedestrian traffic flow along the Seafront and would result in congestion that would compromise the convenience and safety of pedestrians and the use of the footpath generally. The proposed placing of tables and chairs at this location would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
