REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

It is considered that -

- (i) while it has been shown that the development, in respect of which a decision to grant permission has been made, will differ materially from the development as set out in the application for permission by reason of condition 7 imposed by the planning authority to which the grant is subject,
- (ii) it has not been shown that the imposition of this condition will materially affect the applicant's enjoyment of the land adjoining the land in respect of which it has been decided to grant permission or reduce the value of the land.
