The submissions on this file and the Inspector's report were considered at an initial Board Meeting held on August 10th 2016 at which point the case was deferred for further consideration.

At a subsequent Board meeting held on 28th October 2016, the Board decided, generally in accordance with the Inspector's report and recommendation, as follows:

To direct the licensing authority to:

Amend conditions 1.10, 1.14 and 6.2, and to

Attach conditions 1.16, 1.17, 1.18, and 2.2

of the licence, generally in accordance with the Inspector's recommendation for the Reasons and Considerations set out below. In completing the case, the Board adopted the Appropriate Assessment screening carried out by the Inspector.

REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Having regard to the location of the site, nature and scale of the discharge and the surface water management systems in place at the site, it is considered that the requirement for appropriate flow monitoring and sampling, as set out in the licence issued by Meath County Council, is both necessary and appropriate in the interests of orderly development and environmental protection. It is also considered that the amended conditions in relation to visual checks, spill kits, and defrayment of licensing authority costs, are reasonable and necessary for the protection of the environment and the orderly administration of the licence.

Amended Conditions 1.10, 1.14 and 6.2 to be drafted as per Inspector's recommendation.
