I have been asked by An Bord Pleanála to refer to the above-mentioned appeal and to the Board order dated the 20th day of November 2024, which issued to parties by post on the 21st day of November 2024.

Please note that an error occurred in the third sentence of condition number 12(a) of the Board's Order in that, the reference to larnrod Éireann Consulting should have stated IE Consulting. Condition 12(a) should correctly read as:

12. (a) Prior to the commencement of development, a construction method statement and detailed design of the proposed bridge crossing the Tolka flood plain, shall be submitted to, and agreed in writing with, the planning authority. Detailed designs shall include, but are not limited to, the foundations, supports, deck, approach embankments, width and span, junctions, geometry, gradients, levels, layout, kerbs, drainage, street lighting, footpaths and cycleways. The minimum soffit levels of the proposed bridge shall be as set out in figure A-1 of Appendix A to the IE Consulting letter reference IE2510/MOF/5996 dated the 20th day of March 2024, with the exception for the soffit level of the most westerly span of the bridge, which shall be a minimum of 70.7 metres above ordnance datum.

Henceforth, the Board's order should be read in conjunction with this letter.
