**APPEAL** by John and Mai Rooney of 33 Hillcourt Road, Glenageary, County Dublin against the decision made on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2015 by Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council to grant subject to conditions a permission to Rachel and Brian Spollen care of Patrycja Rogala of 207 The Park, Colon Brugh, Sandyford, Dublin in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council.

**PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT:** Retention of 31.9 square metres single storey, rear, flat roof extension at 35 Hillcourt Road, Glenageary, County Dublin.

#### **DECISION**

GRANT permission for the above proposed development in accordance with the said plans and particulars based on the reasons and considerations under and subject to the conditions set out below.

#### MATTERS CONSIDERED

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

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#### REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Having regard to the provisions of the Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Development Plan 2010-2016, to the pattern of existing development in the area and to the design and scale of the extension, it is considered that, subject to compliance with the conditions set out below, the development proposed to be retained would not seriously injure the residential or visual amenities of the area or of property in the vicinity, would respect the existing character of the area and would be acceptable in terms of traffic safety and convenience. The development proposed to be retained would, therefore, be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.

#### CONDITIONS

1. The development shall be retained in accordance with the plans and particulars lodged with the application, except as may otherwise be required in order to comply with the following conditions.

Reason: In the interest of clarity.

2. Water supply and drainage arrangements, including the disposal of surface water, shall comply with the requirements of the planning authority for such works and services.

**Reason:** In the interest of public health.
