APPEAL by Vodafone Ireland Limited care of 4Site Telecoms of 4Site House, Raheen Business Park, Limerick in relation to the application by Mayo County Council of the terms of the Development Contribution Scheme made for the area in respect of condition number 5 of its decision made on the 10th day of November, 2015.

PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT: Retention of an existing 36 metres telecommunications support structure, associated antenna and link dishes, existing Omni antennas fixed to top of mast, giving overall height of 38.8 metres, associated containerised equipment shelter and associated equipment cabinet, located at Eircom AEH, Clare Townland, Claremorris, County Mayo. The development forms part of Vodafone Ireland Limited's existing GSM, 3G and 4G broadband telecommunications networks.

DECISION

The Board, in accordance with section 48 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, considered, based on the reasons and considerations set out below, that the terms of the Development Contribution Scheme for the area had not been properly applied in respect of condition number 5 and directs the said Council to REMOVE condition number 5 and the reason therefor.

REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

The proposed development is for continuance of use of an existing telecommunications mast and mobile phone infrastructure. In the absence of any specific provision in the Mayo County Council Development Contribution Scheme for the levying of financial contributions in respect of telecommunications masts and mobile phone infrastructure, it is considered that the terms of the Scheme have not been properly applied by the planning authority in this instance.

MATTERS CONSIDERED

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.
