APPEAL by Johanna and Barry Mulligan care of David Mulcahy of 67 The Old Mill Race, Athgaravan, County Kildare against the decision made on the 19th day of April, 2016 by Dublin City Council to grant subject to conditions a permission in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council.

PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT: Construction of a new single storey porch to front (three square metres), construction of a new single storey extension to side (31 square metres), construction of a new single storey extension to rear (two square metres), modification of rear elevation including the construction of a dormer window at attic level, enlargement of window to the northside elevation, provision of two number new roof lights to north and south sides, amendment to the internal layout at ground and first floor levels, all associated ancillary, landscaping and site development works, all at 57A South Hill, Dartry, Dublin.

DECISION

Having regard to the nature of the condition the subject of the appeal, the Board is satisfied that the determination by the Board of the relevant application as if it had been made to it in the first instance would not be warranted and, based on the reasons and considerations set out below, directs the said Council under subsection (1) of section 139 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 to REMOVE condition number 2 and the reason therefor.

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REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Having regard to the provisions of the current Development Plan, to the nature and scale of the proposed development and to the pattern of development in the area, it is considered that subject to compliance with the conditions attached the decision of the planning authority, the proposed development would not seriously injure the amenities of the area or of property in the vicinity or give rise to a traffic hazard. The proposed development would, therefore, be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.

MATTERS CONSIDERED

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.
