**APPEAL** by Three Ireland (Hutchison) Limited of 28/29 Sir John Rogerson's Quay, Dublin in relation to the application by Mayo County Council of the terms of the Development Contribution Scheme made for the area in respect of condition number 5 of its decision made on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2016.

**PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT:** Retention of an existing 24 metres high monopole (previously granted permission under planning register reference number 09768 and An Bord Pleanála appeal reference number PL16.236015 which was a temporary permission for a period of 5 years which has expired), carrying antennas and transmission dish with associated equipment cabinet and security fencing at Treanfahanaun West, Treanfahanaun (Treenabontry), Meelick, Swinford, County Mayo.

#### DECISION

The Board, in accordance with section 48 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, considered, based on the reasons and considerations set out below, that the terms of the Development Contribution Scheme for the area had not been properly applied in respect of condition number 5 and directs the said Council to REMOVE condition number 5 and the reason therefor.

#### REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Having regard to the fact that there is no stated provision in the Mayo County Council Development Contribution Scheme for the levying of financial contributions in respect of the provision or retention of telecommunications masts, antennas or associated equipment, the Board considered that the terms of the said scheme had not been properly applied in this case.

### MATTERS CONSIDERED

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.
