APPEAL by Three Ireland (Hutchison) Limited of 28/29 Sir John Rogerson's Quay, Dublin in relation to the application by Mayo County Council of the terms of the Development Contribution Scheme made for the area in respect of condition number 5 of its decision made on the 19th day of May, 2016.

PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT: Retention of an existing 24 metres high lattice tower (previously granted permission under planning register reference number 09756 and An Bord Pleanála appeal reference number PL 16.236014 which was a temporary permission for a period of 5 years which has expired), carrying antennas and transmission dish with associated ground equipment, security fencing and access track at Reservoir Tullynahoo, Midfield, Swinford, County Mayo.

DECISION

The Board, in accordance with section 48 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, considered, based on the reasons and considerations set out below, that the terms of the Development Contribution Scheme for the area had not been properly applied in respect of condition number 5 and directs the said Council to REMOVE condition number 5 and the reason therefor.

REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Having regard to the fact that there is no stated provision in the Mayo County Council Development Contribution Scheme for the levying of financial contributions in respect of the provision or retention of telecommunications masts, antennas or associated equipment, the Board considered that the terms of the said scheme had not been properly applied in this case.
