PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT: Change of use of the ground floor from public offices to betting office (totalling 75 square metres), a new external bin storage area to the rear (three square metres) and a new hardwood fascia with painted lettering (3.64 square metres) at the former FÁS offices, 3 Monastery Road, Clondalkin, Dublin.

DECISION

REFUSE permission for the above proposed development based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

The proposed change of use from café to a betting office would consolidate an excessive concentration of betting office uses at this central location, within the core of the town of Clondalkin, which would impact negatively on the vibrancy of the town and undermine the viability and vitality of the Town Centre as a whole and would, therefore, be contrary to policies Urban Centre 1 and 5.9.0 of the South Dublin County Development Plan 2016-2022. The proposed development would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
