Amendment of Board Order

Planning Authority: Louth County Council

Planning Register Reference Number: 16/524

Development Concerned: Solar PV energy development of maximum export capacity 4 Mega Watts to include one ESB Networks substation building with a height not exceeding of 4 metres, two electrical transformer stations with a height of 2.7 metres, site access roads and solar PV panels mounted on steel support structures 2.65 metres in height, associated cabling and ducting and fencing at Willville, Dundalk, County Louth.

WHEREAS the Board made a decision to grant permission, subject to conditions, in relation to the above-mentioned development by Order dated the 29th day of January, 2018.

AND WHEREAS it has come to the attention of the Board that a clerical error had occurred in condition number 2.

AND WHEREAS the Board considered that the correction of the above-mentioned error would not result in a material alteration of the terms of the development, the subject of the permission or decision.

AND WHEREAS having regard to the nature of the issue involved, the Board decided not to invite submissions in relation to the matter from persons who had made submissions or observations in relation to the appeal the subject of this amendment.

NOW THEREFORE in accordance with section 146A(1) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, the Board hereby amends the above-mentioned decision so that condition number 2 of its Order and the reason therefor shall be as follows:

2. The period during which the development hereby permitted may be carried out shall be five years from the date of this Order.
