REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

It is the policy of the planning authority, as set out in the current Development Plan for the area, that housing will be encouraged in existing towns and villages where services are already available or can be economically provided. Having regard to the extent of new residential development already permitted within the overall landholding from which the appeal site is formed, it is considered that the proposed development, which does not cater for locally derived housing needs, would conflict with the policies as set out in the Development Plan and would seriously injure the amenities of the area. The proposed development would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
