

## **Board Order PL 08.248266**

Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2018

**Planning Authority: Kerry County Council**

Appeal by Kerry Tarmacadam Manufacturing Limited care of SLR Consulting Ireland of 7 Dundrum Business Park, Windy Arbour, Dublin against the decision made on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2017 by Kerry County Council for permission for development comprising (a) retention permission to retain a quarried area of 1.7 hectares outside of the quarry area permitted under planning register reference number 06/2419, (b) permission for the recommencement and continuation of guarrying activities on the overall site of 3.3 hectares to include crushing, screening and processing of rock, and all ancillary site works, (c) permission for blasting and washing of aggregate, (d) installation of a packaged wastewater treatment system and polishing filter, all at Farranastack Townland, Lisselton, County Kerry in accordance with the plans and particulars lodged with the said Council (which decision was to grant subject to condition permission for (a) retention permission to retain a quarried area of 1.7 hectares outside of the quarry area permitted under planning register reference number 06/2419 and to refuse permission for (b) permission for the recommencement and continuation of quarrying activities on the overall site of 3.3 hectares to include crushing, screening and processing of rock, and all ancillary site works, (c) permission for blasting and washing of aggregate, (d) installation of a packaged wastewater treatment system and polishing filter.

## **Decision**

REFUSE permission for the above proposed development based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

## **Matters Considered**

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

## **Reasons and Considerations**

It is considered that the road network serving the quarry site does not have sufficient capacity to handle the traffic associated with the development proposed to be retained and the proposed development. The development proposed to be retained and the proposed development would, therefore, endanger public safety by reason of traffic hazard and obstruction of road users, and would be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
