

APPLICATION FOR LEAVE TO APPEAL against the decision of the planning authority by Neil and Kathleen Gleeson of 2 Cenacle Grove, Killiney Hill Road, Killiney, County Dublin having an interest in land adjoining the land in respect of which Dún Laoghaire-Rathdown County Council decided on the 18th day of October, 2017 to grant subject to conditions a permission to Ruth Tracey care of Blupan Group of 20 Waltham Abbey, Old Quarter, Ballincollig, County Cork.

PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT: Construction of a two-storey dwellinghouse consisting of ground floor over lower ground floor (basement), demolition of existing garage and side wall and all ancillary site works relevant to the development at Holly Lodge, Cenacle Grove, Killiney Hill Road, Killiney, County Dublin.

DECISION

REFUSE leave to appeal under section 37 (6) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

MATTERS CONSIDERED

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Having regard to the submissions and documents received in connection with the application for leave to appeal and the conditions set out in the planning authority's decision, it is considered that it has not been shown that the development in respect of which a decision to grant permission has been made will differ materially from the development as set out in the application for permission by reason of conditions imposed by the planning authority to which the grant is subject.
