

Application for leave to appeal against the decision of the planning authority by Gerard and Yvonne Seery of Fennville, Carrick Road, Edenderry, County Offaly having an interest in land adjoining the land in respect of which Offaly County Council decided on the 2nd day of January, 2018 to grant subject to conditions a permission to Nathy McIntyre care of Downey Planning of 1 Westland Square, Pearse Street, Dublin.

Proposed Development: Change of use of a crèche unit (previously permitted under planning register reference number 00/899; An Bord Pleanála appeal reference number PL19.123783) to a residential use (to now provide a single storey, three-bedroom, detached dwelling) along with all associated site works necessary to facilitate the proposed development at 13 Carrickhall Lane, Edenderry, County Offaly.

Decision

REFUSE leave to appeal under section 37 (6) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the submissions and documents received in connection with the application for leave to appeal and the condition set out in the planning authority's decision, it is considered that it has not been shown that the development in respect of which a decision to grant permission has been made will differ materially from the development as set out in the application for permission by reason of condition imposed by the planning authority to which the grant is subject.
