

Board Order ABP-301474-18

Local Government (No. 2) Act, 1960

Planning Authority: Meath County Council

Application received by An Bord Pleanála on the 20th day of April, 2018 from Meath County Council pursuant to section 76 of, and the Third Schedule to, the Housing Act, 1966 as extended by section 10 of the Local Government (No. 2) Act, 1960 (as substituted by section 86 of the Housing Act, 1966) and the Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2018, for confirmation of a compulsory purchase order authorising compulsory acquisition of lands and entitled **Meath County Council R150 Laytown – Bettystown Spine Road Compulsory Purchase (No. 2) Order, 2018.**

Decision

CONFIRM the above compulsory purchase order subject to the modifications set out in the Schedule hereto and for the reasons and considerations set out below.

Reasons and Considerations

Having considered the objections made to the compulsory purchase order and the report of the person who conducted the oral hearing into the objections and having regard to:

- (a) the objections made to the Compulsory Purchase Order, and not withdrawn,
- (b) the purposes of the compulsory acquisition for the R150 Laytown-Bettystown Spine Road,
- (c) the provisions of the Meath County Development Plan 2013-2019,
- (d) the community need, public interest served and benefits to be achieved from use of the acquired lands for the purpose identified in the order,
- (e) the report of the Inspector who held the oral hearing, and
- (f) the documents and submissions on file generally.

It is considered that, subject to the modifications set out below, the acquisition of the lands in question by the local authority is necessary for the purpose stated in the order and the objections cannot be sustained having regard to this necessity.

SCHEDULE

Part III of the Schedule shall be amended to reflect the proposal to extinguish Public Right of Way (AA) on a temporary basis only, as clarified by the oral submission of Counsel on behalf of Meath County Council.

Reason: To take account of the submission made by Meath County Council at the oral hearing proposing the amendments as referred to above.
