Board Order ABP-302104-18

Appeal by Maeve Magee, Magee's Pharmacy care of Hughes Planning and Development Consultants of 70 Pearse Street, Dublin in accordance with section 9(1) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015 against the entry on the Vacant Sites Register by Wicklow County Council on the 19th day of June, 2018 in respect of the site described below.

Description: Site at Magee's Pharmacy, Enniskerry, County Wicklow.

Decision

The Board in accordance with section 9(3) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015, and based on the reasons and considerations set out below, hereby determines that the above site is not a vacant site within the meaning of that Act.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to:

- (a) the information submitted to the Board by the planning authority in relation to the entry of the site on the Vacant Sites Register,
- (b) the grounds of appeal submitted by the appellant,
- (c) the report of the Inspector, and
- (d) the condition of the site, while extensively covered with trees and vegetation is not neglected and does not display any visible evidence of anti-social behaviour and, therefore, it is considered that it does not have adverse effects on the existing amenities or character of the area,

the Board considered that it is appropriate that a notice be issued to the planning authority to cancel the entry on the Vacant Sites Register.
