Application for Leave to Appeal against the decision of the planning authority by Patricia Curry of 48 Bulfin Road, Inchicore, Dublin having an interest in land adjoining the land in respect of which Dublin City Council decided on the 5th day of July, 2018 to grant subject to conditions a permission to Wu Chen care of Dublin Planning, Coliemore House, Coliemore Road, Dalkey, County Dublin.

Proposed Development: Change of use of premises within a ground floor unit of circa 90 square metres from a café restaurant and deli to a fast-food take-away outlet at 47A and B, Bulfin Road, Inchicore, Dublin.

Decision

REFUSE leave to appeal under section 37 (6) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the submissions and documents received in connection with the application for leave to appeal and the conditions set out in the planning authority's decision, it is considered that it has not been shown that the development in respect of which a decision to grant permission has been made will differ materially from the development as set out in the application for permission by reason of conditions imposed by the planning authority to which the grant is subject.
