Application for an Extension of Time to Apply for Substitute Consent by Kilcarrig Quarries Limited care of Earth Science Partnership (Ireland) Limited of Tonranny, Westport, County Mayo pursuant to the determination by Carlow County Council on the 25th day of October, 2018, requiring the owner/operator to apply to An Bord Pleanála for substitute consent.

Development: Quarry at Roscat, Ardristan, Tullow, County Carlow.

Decision

Grant an extension of the period for the making of an application for substitute consent under section 177E (4) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as inserted by section 57 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010, for a Further Period of 12 Weeks from the end of the original 12 week period that commenced on the 25th day of October, 2018, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

The Board noted the request made for the extension of the period for the making of an application for substitute consent in this instance and considered it appropriate that the further period should be 12 weeks, as opposed to the additional 20 week-period sought. In making this decision, the Board had regard to the circumstances of the case, the nature and scale of the operations and was of the opinion that the extended period of 12 weeks would be adequate to prepare a comprehensive remedial Environmental Impact Statement and remedial Natura Impact Statement in accordance with Sections 177F and 177G of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended.
