**APPEAL** by Cignal Infrastructure Limited care of 4Site, 4Site House, Raheen Business Park, Limerick against the decision made on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2018 by Wicklow County Council to refuse permission.

**Proposed Development:** Installation of an 8.5 metre high flagpole replica telecommunication's support structure to internally house antenna at the rear gable end of the Horse and Hound in Delgany. The development will also include the erection of one number transmission dish at the roof level including radio units, together with associated ground equipment cabinets and associated site works at The Horse and Hound, Convent Road, Delgany, County Wicklow.

**Decision**

**REFUSE** permission for the above proposed development in accordance with the reasons and considerations set out below.

## **Matters Considered**

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

## **Reasons and Considerations**

The proposed development, by reason of its design, height and location set within the Delgany Village Architectural Conservation Area would form a visually intrusive feature which would adversely impact upon the character of the Delgany Village Architectural Conservation Area. The proposed development would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
