

Board Order ABP-303377-19

Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2018 Planning Authority: South Dublin County Council Planning Register Reference Number: SD18B/0419.

Appeal by Lauren Gilmer care of Thornton O'Connor Town Planning of Number 1 Kilmacud Road Upper, Drundrum, Dublin against the decision made on the 3rd day of December, 2018 by South Dublin County Council to refuse permission for the proposed development.

Proposed Development: Retention of modifications to the single storey rear extension as approved under planning register reference number SD13B/0419, consisting of an increase in area from 45 square metres as approved to 79 square metres as constructed and the increase in height of the parapet from 2.9 metres to 3.1 metres, along with the inclusion of a raised central roof light at "Cherbury", Old Bridge Road, Templeogue, Dublin.

Decision

GRANT permission for the above proposed development in accordance with the said plans and particulars based on the reasons and considerations under and subject to the conditions set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the zoning provisions for the site, to the nature and scale of the development subject to retention, and to the existing pattern of development in the vicinity, it is considered that, subject to compliance with the conditions set out below, the development for which retention is sought would not be out of character with development in the area and would not seriously injure the residential or visual amenities of the area or of property in the vicinity. The development for which retention is sought would, therefore, be in accordance with the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.

Conditions

1. The development shall be retained in accordance with the plans and particulars lodged with the application, as amended by the revised plans submitted to An Bord Pleanála on the 8th day of January, 2019 reducing the parapet level along the north-eastern boundary (drawing number ABP_422_P_02-02), except as may otherwise be required in order to comply with the following conditions. Where such conditions require details to be agreed with the planning authority, the developer shall agree such details in writing with the planning authority and the development shall be retained in accordance with the agreed particulars.

Reason: In the interest of clarity.

2. Water supply and drainage arrangements, including the attenuation and disposal of surface water, shall comply with the requirements of the planning authority for such works and services.

Reason: In the interest of public health.

3. The developer shall pay to the planning authority a financial contribution in respect of public infrastructure and facilities benefiting development in the area of the planning authority that is provided or intended to be provided by or on behalf of the authority in accordance with the terms of the Development Contribution Scheme made under section 48 of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended. The contribution shall be paid within two months of the date of this Order or in such phased payments as the planning authority may facilitate and shall be subject to any applicable indexation provisions of the Scheme at the time of payment. Details of the application of the terms of the Scheme shall be agreed between the planning authority and the developer or, in default of such agreement, the matter shall be referred to An Bord Pleanála to determine the proper application of the terms of the Scheme.

Reason: It is a requirement of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, that a condition requiring a contribution in accordance with the Development Contribution Scheme made under section 48 of the Act be applied to the permission.
