**Board Order
ABP-303473-19**

Appeal by Ardglan Property Holdings Limited care of PDC Architectural of Churchfields, Kenstown, Navan, County Meath in accordance with section 9(1) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015 against the entry on the Vacant Sites Register by Meath County Council on the 14th day of December, 2018 in respect of the site described below.

Description: Site at Hunters Lane, Ashbourne, County Meath.

Decision

The Board in accordance with section 9(3) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015, and based on the reasons and considerations set out below, hereby determines that the above site was not a vacant site within the meaning of that Act for the period concerned.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to:

- (a) the information submitted to the Board by the planning authority in relation to the entry of the site on the Vacant Sites Register,
- (b) the grounds of appeal submitted by the appellant,
- (c) the report of the Inspector, and
- (d) the site could not have been a vacant site within the meaning of section 5(1)(a) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act, 2015, as amended, for the reason that the assessment of the site did not account for the duration of the 12 months preceding the date of entry on the register in accordance with section 6(2) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act, 2015, as amended,
