

Board Order ABP-303534-19

Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015

Appeal by Carlow College Saint Patrick's care of Planning and Design Solutions of Lismard House, Tullow Street, Carlow in accordance with section 9(1) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015, as amended, against the entry on the Vacant Sites Register by Carlow County Council on the 18th day of December, 2018 in respect of the site described below.

Description: Site at the junction of College Street and Old Dublin Road, Carlow.

Decision

The Board in accordance with section 9(3) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015, as amended, and based on the reasons and considerations set out below, hereby determines that the above site was not a vacant site within the meaning of that Act for the period concerned.

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Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to:

- (a) the information submitted to the Board by the planning authority in relation to the entry of the site on the Vacant Sites Register,
- (b) the grounds of appeal submitted by the appellant,
- (c) the report of the Inspector,
- (d) the absence of sufficient evidence to support the contention of the planning authority that the site was vacant and idle for the period of 12 months preceding the date of placing the site on the register, and
- (e) the fact that the site was not specifically identified for regeneration as required by the definition of "regeneration land" as set out in section 3 of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015, as amended, which states that regeneration land identified by a planning authority in its development plan or local area plan, after the coming into operation of section 28 in accordance with section 10(2)(h) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, with the objective of development and renewal of areas in need of regeneration, and includes any structures on such land at the time the Notice was issued,

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the Board considered that it is appropriate that a notice be issued to the planning authority to cancel the entry on the Vacant Sites Register.
