Application for Leave to Appeal against the decision of the planning authority by Maura and Bobby Barron of 7 Barrow Lough, Leighlinbridge, County Carlow having an interest in land adjoining the land in respect of which Carlow County Council decided on the 15th day of January, 2019 to grant subject to conditions a permission to Noreside Construction Limited care of Dalton O'Donnell of The Butterslip, Kilkenny.

Proposed Development: Construction of four number three bedroom semi-detached houses, one number three bedroom detached house plus all associated site works, boundary walls/railings, public footpath and car parking at Church Street/New Road, Ballyknockan, Leighlinbridge, County Carlow.

Decision

REFUSE leave to appeal under section 37 (6) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the submissions and documents received in connection with the application for leave to appeal and the conditions set out in the planning authority's decision, it is considered that it has not been shown that the development in respect of which a decision to grant permission has been made will differ materially from the development as set out in the application for permission by reason of conditions imposed by the planning authority to which the grant is subject.
