

Board Order ABP-304277-19

Derelict Sites Act, 1990

Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2019

Planning Authority: Limerick City and County Council

Application received by An Bord Pleanála on the 23rd day of April, 2019 from Limerick City and County Council pursuant to section 16 of the Derelict Sites Act, 1990, as amended, for consent to the compulsory acquisition of a site at 1 Long Lane, Sir Harry's Mall, Limerick and as more particularly described in the notice of intention to compulsorily acquire the site.

Decision

GRANT consent to the compulsory acquisition of the said site based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the neglected, unsightly and objectionable condition of the site and the ruinous, derelict and dangerous condition of the property, it is considered that the site detracts to a material degree from the amenity, character and appearance of land in the neighbourhood and, therefore, comes within the definition of a derelict site as defined in sections 3(a) and 3(b) of the Derelict Sites Act 1990, as amended. Therefore, it is considered that the acquisition by the local authority of the site in question, as set out in the Order and on the deposited map, is justified and necessary in order to render the site non-derelict and to prevent it continuing to be a derelict site. It is also considered that the objection made cannot be sustained, having regard to that said necessity.
