

## Board Order ABP-304495-19

Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2019

**Planning Authority: Galway County Council**

**APPEAL** by Transport Infrastructure Ireland of Parkgate Business Centre, Parkgate Street, Dublin against the decision made on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2019 by Galway County Council to grant subject to conditions a permission to Jonathan O'Donnell care of ETM Chartered Engineers Limited of Oughterard, County Galway.

**Proposed Development:** Construction of a dwellinghouse, garage/shed and private wastewater treatment system with all associated works and ancillary services at Pollagh, Woodstock, County Galway.

## Decision

REFUSE permission for the above proposed development in accordance with the reasons and considerations set out below.

## **Matters Considered**

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

## **Reasons and Considerations**

The proposed development would result in the intensification of the use of an existing access onto the heavily trafficked N59 National Secondary Road at a location where the maximum speed limit applies. The proposed development would be at variance with national policy in relation to the control of development on national roads as set out in the Spatial Planning and National Roads Guidelines for Planning Authorities issued by the Department of the Environment, Community and Local Government in January, 2012, which seeks to secure the efficiency, capacity and safety of the national road network. The proposed development, by itself, or by the precedent which the grant of permission for it would set for other relevant development, would, therefore, adversely affect the use of a national road by traffic and would be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
