Application for Leave to Appeal against the decision of the planning authority by Annemount Management Company Limited by Guarantee care of Joe Bonner of The Airport Hub, Unit 1, Furry Park, Old Swords Road, Santry, Dublin, having an interest in land adjoining the land in respect of which Cork County Council decided on the 29th day of April, 2019 to grant subject to conditions a permission to Hobleton Limited care of McCutcheon Halley of 6 Joyce House, Barrack Square, Ballincollig, County Cork.

Proposed Development: Construction of 62 number houses, realignment of the internal road and all ancillary development works. This is a modification to a residential scheme permitted under planning register reference number 06/11830 and extended by planning register reference numbers 12/4124 and 17/6075; and will result in an increase in the number of units from the permitted 57 number houses to 62 number houses. Access to the proposed development will be the existing access via Abbey Lane and includes dwellings that will be accessed from Sorrel Avenue and Aster Lawn, all at Rath-Beg, Abbey-Lands, Kinsale, County Cork.

Decision

REFUSE leave to appeal under section 37 (6) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the submissions and documents received in connection with the application for leave to appeal and the conditions set out in the planning authority's decision, it is considered that it has not been shown that the development in respect of which a decision to grant permission has been made will differ materially from the development as set out in the application for permission by reason of conditions imposed by the planning authority to which the grant is subject.
