

Board Order ABP-305213-19

Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2019

Planning Authority: Sligo County Council

APPLICATION by Donald and Anita O'Connor of Slieve Daeane, Cleveragh Drive, Sligo requesting An Bord Pleanála to consider and determine, in accordance with its powers under article 120(3)(a) of the Planning and Development Regulations, 2001, as amended, whether the local authority should be directed to prepare an environmental impact assessment report in respect of a proposed development of the 'Lest Sligo Forgets' Great War Memorial Garden together with all associated site works at the entrance to the Regional Park, Cleveragh, Sligo.

DECISION

NOT TO DIRECT the local authority to prepare an environmental impact assessment report in respect of the said proposed development based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

Having regard to the following:

- (a) the criteria set out in Schedule 7 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001, as amended,
- (b) the limited nature and scale of the proposed development,
- (c) the location of the site and the existing pattern of development in the vicinity,
- (d) the limited potential for significant impacts arising from the proposed development, and
- (e) the submission of the planning authority,

it is considered that the proposed development would not be likely to have significant effects on the environment and that the preparation and submission of an environmental impact assessment report is not, therefore, required.
