

Board Order ABP-306357-20

Appeal by Tony and Mary McNally care of Dixon McGaver Nolan Architects of 14 Lower Baggot Street, Dublin against the decision made on the 6th day of December, 2019 by Dublin City Council to grant subject to conditions a permission to Tim and Anita Evans care of Vicky Landy of 53 Kincora Road, Clontarf, Dublin in accordance with plans and particulars lodged with the said Council.

Proposed Development: Construction of a proposed dormer extension to rear of existing dwelling at attic level at 35 Saint Lawrence Road, Clontarf, Dublin which is a Protected Structure.

Decision

GRANT permission for the above proposed development in accordance with the said plans and particulars based on the reasons and considerations under and subject to the conditions set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by

virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made

thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any

submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory

provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard its detailed design and finishes, and to its integration into the

existing roof profile, it is considered that the proposed development, subject to

compliance with the conditions set out below, would not detract from the

character of the protected structure or interfere with the visual and residential

amenities of the area and would, therefore, be in accordance with the proper

planning and sustainable development of the area.

Conditions

1. The development shall be carried out and completed in accordance with

the plans and particulars lodged with the application, except as may

otherwise be required in order to comply with the following condition.

Reason: In the interest of clarity.

 The dormer window shall be finished with a dark grey standing seam cladding, and all fascia/soffits, rainwater goods, window frames and glazing bars shall be in a dark colour so as to blend with the existing roof.

Reason: In the interest of visual amenity and to protect the character of the protected structure.
