

## Board Order ABP-306387-20

Local Government (No. 2) Act, 1960

Housing Act, 1966

Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2020

**Applicant: Irish Water** 

**Application** received by An Bord Pleanála on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2020 from Irish Water pursuant to section 76 of, and the Third Schedule to, the Housing Act, 1966 as extended by section 10 of the Local Government (No.2) Act, 1960 (as substituted by section 86 of the Housing Act, 1966) and the Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2020, for confirmation of a Compulsory Purchase Order authorising compulsory acquisition of lands and entitled **Irish Water Compulsory Purchase (Liscannor Sewerage Scheme) Order, 2019.** 

## **DECISION**

CONFIRM the above Compulsory Purchase Order without modifications, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

## **REASONS AND CONSIDERATIONS**

Having considered the objection made to the Compulsory Purchase Order and the Inspector's report assessing the objection, and having regard to the provisions of the Water Framework Directive (2000/60/EC), the Urban Wastewater Treatment Directive (91/271/EEC), and the current Clare County Development Plan, it is considered that the acquisition of lands, wayleaves, rights of way and temporary working areas by Irish Water is necessary for the purposes stated in the Order and on the deposited map, and the objection cannot be sustained having regard to the said necessity.
