APPEAL by Cellnex – Signal Infrastructure Limited of Suite 311, Q House, 76 Furze Road, Sandyford Industrial Estate, Dublin against the decision made on the 18th day of December, 2019 by Cork City Council to refuse to grant a licence.

APPLICATION: Licence for the construction of a 15-metre Alpha 2.0 telecommunications monopole and cabinet at Lakeland (Ringmahon Road), Cork.

Decision

In exercise of the powers conferred on it under section 254 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, An Bord Pleanála hereby DISALLOWS the appeal based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

On the basis of the information submitted with the application and the appeal, including the information submitted in response to section 131 and section 132 notices, the Board is not satisfied that the proposed siting of the telecommunications infrastructure is over or along a public road in accordance with the requirements of section 254 of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, but is on public open space, and it is considered that the Board cannot grant a licence for the proposed development in such circumstances
