

Board Order ABP-306969-20

Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015

Appeal by EasyHotel PLC care of Mason, Hayes and Curran of Barrow Street, Dublin in accordance with section 18 of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015, as amended, against a demand for payment of vacant site levy issued by Dublin City Council on the 24th day of February, 2020 in respect of the site described below.

Description: Numbers 28-31 Benburb Street, Dublin.

Decision

The Board in accordance with section 18(3) of the Urban Regeneration and Housing Act 2015, as amended, and based on the reasons and considerations set out below, hereby determines that the above site was no longer a vacant site within the meaning of that Act.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made



thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to:

- the information submitted to the Board by the planning authority in (a) relation to the entry of the site on the Vacant Sites Register,
- (b) the grounds of appeal submitted by the appellant,
- (c) the report of the Planning Inspector, and
- (d) the demolition activities that took place during 2019, the secure and fenced condition of the site during 2020, and the ongoing construction activities that have and are taking place on the site,

the Board is not satisfied that the site was a vacant site on the 23rd day of March 2020, the date on which the appeal was made.

The Board, therefore, considers that it is appropriate that a notice be issued to the planning authority who shall cancel the entry on the Vacant Sites Register and cancel the demand for payment.
