Application for an Extension of Time to Apply for Substitute Consent by Murray Brothers Tarmacadam Limited care of McCutcheon Halley of 6 Joyce House, Barrack Square, Ballincollig, County Cork pursuant to the determination by An Bord Pleanála on the 5th day of March, 2020, requiring the owner/operator to apply to An Bord Pleanála for substitute consent.

Development: Quarry at Ardcahan (Townland), Dunmanway, Co. Cork.

Decision

Grant an extension of the period for the making of an application for substitute consent under section 177E (4) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as inserted by section 57 of the Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010, for a Further Period of 13 Weeks from the end of the original 12 week period that commenced on the 5th day of March, 2020, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

The Board noted the request made for an extension of the period for the making of the application for substitute consent in this instance, arising from the need to complete necessary close-out issues on the case. It is considered that an extension of 13 weeks would be reasonable and appropriate to enable completion of application documentation to the necessary standard.
