Application for Leave to Appeal against the decision of the planning authority by Nora Murphy of Knockduff Upper, The Bridge, Meelin, Newmarket, County Cork having an interest in land adjoining the land in respect of which Cork County Council decided on the 13th day of July, 2020 to grant subject to conditions permission to Eily O'Callaghan care of Denis O'Connor of 23 Clarinwood, Rathmore, County Kerry.

Proposed Development: Construction of a new easy feed slatted livestock unit adjacent to existing farm building. Proposed livestock unit to incorporate crush, creep area and associated underground slurry storage tanks with four external agitation points and ancillary external concrete. The above development to be carried out with all associated ancillary site works at Knockduff Upper, Meelin, Newmarket, County Cork.

Decision

REFUSE leave to appeal under section 37 (6) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, based on the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.
