**APPEAL** by Caitlín Uí Aodha, Iasc Seafood Bar of 78 and 86 O'Connell Street, Dungarvan, County Waterford against the decision made on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2020 by Waterford City and County to refuse to grant a licence.

**APPLICATION:** Street Furniture Licence for outdoor seating consisting of picnic style tables and benches at Iasc Seafood Bar, 78 O'Connell Street, Dungarvan, County Waterford.

**DECISION**

**In exercise of the powers conferred on it under section 254 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, An Bord Pleanála hereby DISALLOWS the said appeal based on the reasons and considerations set out below.**

## **Matters Considered**

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

## **Reasons and Considerations**

It is considered that the location of the proposed street furniture would compromise the functioning of an existing commercial loading bay to the front of the subject premises which would be likely to result in disruption to traffic and parking in the vicinity and may compromise the convenience and safety of road users including pedestrians. It is, therefore, considered that the proposed development would be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
