**Amendment of Board Order**

**Planning Authority: Galway County Council.**

**Planning Register Reference Number: 20/499.**

**Development Concerned:** A twenty year planning permission for the continued operation of the existing quarry and all associated uses and activities, as well as for an extension to the existing quarry extraction area and all associated site works including landscaping arrangements at Barrettspark, Athenry, County Galway. The proposed quarry extension area is on lands to the north, south and east of the existing quarry and the additional extraction area amounts to approximately 6.7 hectares.

**WHEREAS** the Board made a decision to grant permission, subject to conditions, in relation to the above-mentioned development by order dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August, 2023:

**AND WHEREAS** it has come to the attention of the Board that due to a clerical error, conditions numbers 3(a) and 6 should be rectified to facilitate the operation of the permission:

**AND WHEREAS** the Board considered that the correction of the above-mentioned error would not result in a material alteration of the terms of the development, the subject of the permission or decision:


**AND WHEREAS** having regard to the nature of the issue involved, the Board decided not to invite submissions in relation to the matter from persons who had made submissions or observations in relation to the permission:

**NOW THEREFORE** in accordance with section 146A(1) of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, the Board hereby amends the above-mentioned decision so that conditions numbers 3(a) and 6 of its Order and the reason therefor shall be as follows:

3. (a) This grant of planning permission for further extraction relates only to the areas outlined on the drawings submitted on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2020. All extraction and processing operations on site shall cease 20 years from the date of the grant of permission. All plant and machinery shall cease operation and shall be removed from site within 20 years of the date of this grant of planning permission.

6. The extraction area, including the depths, shall be as indicated in section 3.3.1 'Proposed Extraction Area' of the Environmental Impact Assessment Report received by the planning authority on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of April, 2020.
