

Board Order ABP-308702-20

Planning and Development Acts 2000 to 2020

Planning Authority: Cavan County Council

Planning Register Reference Number: 20/378

APPEAL by John O'Reilly of Ballinlough, Belturbet, County Cavan against the decision made on the 23rd day of October, 2020 by Cavan County Council to refuse permission.

Proposed Development: Develop new bellmouth vehicular entrance to existing dwelling and associated works at Ballinlough, Belturbet, County Cavan.

Decision

REFUSE permission for the above proposed development in accordance with the reasons and considerations set out below.

Matters Considered

In making its decision, the Board had regard to those matters to which, by virtue of the Planning and Development Acts and Regulations made thereunder, it was required to have regard. Such matters included any submissions and observations received by it in accordance with statutory provisions.

Reasons and Considerations

Having regard to the location and layout of the proposed new entrance and the extent of the proposed new driveway to an existing dwelling which already has the benefit of an existing vehicular entrance, it is considered that the proposed development would set an undesirable precedent for the development of new entrances onto a regional road, would comprise an unnecessary new access onto the regional road at this location and would not be of a design appropriate to an entrance and boundary for a dwelling in this rural area. In this regard, the proposed development would be contrary to objectives DMO24, DM025 and DM027 of the Cavan County Development Plan 2014-2020. The proposed development would, therefore, be contrary to the proper planning and sustainable development of the area.
